- Review of last meeting's minutes
  - Motion – Katrina Six
  - Second – Toni Ogden
- Treasurer's Report (Toni Ogden)
  - Since the Bear Stampede, we still have donations coming in from companies' dollar matching programs
  - Other significant items to include shade structure, dinners out, boo boxes, etc. discussed throughout meeting.
- Vote to Cancel Shade Structure Project for 2021-2022 school year
  - Last year PTC voted on the \$31K shade structure.
  - PTC to contribute \$25,000 and Blue Oaks to contribute \$6,000
  - Determined at the end of the school year that there were additional expenses
  - New estimate that Mrs. Cumbra was able to get with the District support was \$58,000
  - District returned the \$25,000 to the PTC
  - Motion to cancel shade structure project – Katrina Six
  - Second – Lori Solis
  - Formal vote done during meeting through Google Forms and all paid PTC members can submit. 5 Votes to Cancel – Lisa Austin, Lori Solis, Kim DeWeese, Katrina Six, Toni Ogden
  - Nicole Cumbra – we are hoping to revisit this again because it is very hot on the upgrade side of the school. Be thinking of other solutions.
- Alternative things to fund:
  - 3 new stop signs for the crossing guards (requested by Mrs. Cumbra) - \$150
  - ["Storyworks" Magazine](#) hard copy and digital subscription for 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> graders. It will help reinforce ELA Essential Standards. (requested by 5<sup>th</sup> grade teachers) - \$1,800
  - 105 copies of the novel, [Hatchet](#), by Gary Paulson and 105 copies of [Bud, not Buddy](#), by Paul Curtis. These will be added to each of the teacher's classroom libraries. (requested by the 5<sup>th</sup> grade teachers) - \$1,100
  - Increase the budgets from \$100 to \$300 for the following (requested by Mrs. Cumbra):
    - Psychologist
    - Speech
    - RSP
    - OT
    - \$800
  - Performance shirts for Bucket Band performance - \$300
    - Shannyn Comstock – design and printing will be doing this at cost for Blue Oaks
  - Seat cushions for students in music class outdoors - \$379
  - Everything mentioned above will be procured immediately and if there are other suggestions, they will be considered at the next meeting.
